## How we calculate holiday accrual

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First we look at how many weeks are actually worked in the year:


Then we show the number of holiday weeks as a \% of actual weeks worked:
We do this because temporary workers do not accumulate holiday accrual during the 5.6 weeks they are on holiday. Therefore we cannot calculate the $\%$ over 52 weeks.


We then use this figure to calculate holiday accrual:
An example: You are contracted to work 37.5 hrs per week (7.5hrs per day). Your basic hourly rate is $£ 10$ ph. Each week your basic pay is $£ 375$. Therefore for each full week worked upi will accrue ( $12.07 \%$ of $£ 375$ ) in holiday pay. This is equal to $£ 45.27$
So, if you worked a full year this would be your full holiday accrual:


To cross check this, here's the calculation for 28 days of holiday, based on 7.5 hrs per day at $£ 10 \mathrm{ph}$. This will exactly match the holiday accrual from the calculation above.
Therefore by using the $12.07 \%$ we can ensure you gain the correct amount of holiday accrual.

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
